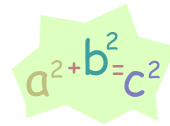

This is an extra chance for pupils to design and create new pieces of work.



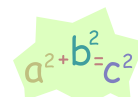
FOOTBALL All 1.00pm-1.30pm School Field Mr Merifield
