**RELIGIOUS EDUCATION**

**CREATION**

Explores being made in the image and likeness of God as seen through the story of Genesis and how we are called to respect all similarities and differences  
Examines issues of reverence and respect in the Jewish faith and the Torah

**CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING**

Catholic Social Teaching and how we can be a good neighbour  
Breaking down walls and building bridges

**CHRISTMAS**

The role of the angels in the story of Christmas as messengers of the Good News of Jesus' birth is examined  
The feasts associated with Christmas such as the Annunciation and the birth of John the Baptist are explored

**LENT**

Examines Jesus' time in the wilderness  
Explores how prayer, fasting, almsgiving and living out the Beatitudes help us prepare for Easter  
Explores the importance of Yom Kippur in the Jewish religion

**EASTER**

Looks at the risen Jesus shown through the Ascension and other stories  
Explores the Hindu festival of Diwali

**SACRAMENTS**

Explores the nature of vocation and its symbolism, this is done through investigating Old Testament stories which show how God calls people in faith and the symbolism of anointing

**CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING**

Learning about Catholic Social Teaching and its links with the Gospels  
The Good Samaritan

**ADVENT**

The first coming of Jesus is placed in historical context through the lives of his ancestors (House of David)

**REVELATION**

Looks at how the apostles and Anna and Simeon saw the glory of Jesus as the only Son of the Father. Explores the revelation of Jesus as the Light of the World  
Looks at the celebrations of light over darkness in the Sikh religion

**HOLY WEEK**

The reasons for the death of Jesus are explored through his Passion and death

**PENTECOST AND MISSION**

Explores the events of Pentecost in detail and looks at how the gift of languages is expressed  
Examines the qualities of a follower of Jesus as expressed in St Paul's letter to the Colossians
